PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

PURPOSE: This course is designed to provide the practicing colon and rectal surgeon with updates on important aspects of caring for patients with colon and rectal diseases. Emphasis is placed on a broad range of topics to address the needs of a diversified group of attendees.

OBJECTIVES: *At the end of this program, the participants should be able to:*

- ✓ Discuss special issues related to the care of colon and rectal symptoms in paraplegic patients
- ✓ Recognize the evidence-based medicine used in determining the non-operative treatment of diverticulitis
- ✓ Review pertinent issues relating to the management of small (6-9 mm) and diminutive (≤ 5 mm) polyps including risk factors for predicting progression to advanced neoplasia and cancer
- ✓ Discuss issues pertinent to the management of patients presenting with advanced stage colorectal cancer with special emphasis and the role for resection of the primary tumor in the face of distant metastatic disease
- ✓ Recognize current state-of-the-art approaches to the management of fecal incontinence and constipation and describe in detail the appropriate workup of patients with complaints of incontinence and constipation
- ✓ Describe the indications, complications, results and technique of Transanal Hemorrhoidal Dearterialization Hemorrhoidopexy (THD-HP)
- ✓ Identify and treat perianal skin conditions
